

Prashasan janta ke dwar held

Most of the grievances of villagers, out of 86, were settled on the spot in "Prashasan Janta Ke Dwar" organized by district administration at village Hobar under Bhattiyat sub-division of the district today.

Presiding over a largely attended camp, which was also attended by district officers also, Deputy Commissioner Devesh Kumar said these camps were being organized at various places in the district to save them from the trouble of visiting offices for getting their problems solved. The villagers got an opportunity for having solutions to various problems at their doorsteps, DC said adding that this would maintain the credibility of the government for the resolution of responsible and transparent governance.

Deputy commissioner directed the authorities of Social Welfare department to cover widows and old-aged persons under pension schemes in a time-bound manner. He also issued directives to PWD to clear the debris from private land.

DC said the remaining few cases required detailed enquiries and those were handed over to the officers concerned with a direction that those must be settled within a stipulated time-frame and the response must also be made available to the DC office.

Among others present on the occasion included Chairman district market committee, Bhupender Singh Chauhan, Superintendent of Police, Madhusudan and district officers of various departments.
